The Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR), a component of the Executive Office of the President (EOP), is a cabinet-level agency responsible for developing and coordinating U.S. international trade, commodity, and direct investment policy, and overseeing trade negotiations with other countries in bilateral, plurilateral, and multilateral discussions and institutions.
