- Raise awareness through social media campaigns, activities, and events





This group will teach youth how to build insight into their thoughts, emotions, and behaviors, and learn how to communicate their needs and wants in a healthy assertive manner. Lastly, with an emphasis on maladaptive coping skills including self-medicating with substances, isolating, or engaging in risky behaviors, youth will learn to develop coping skills needed to manage symptoms on a long-term basis.

The LGBTQ Center OC provides advocacy and education support to at least 50 Gender and Sexualities Alliances, Gay-Straight Alliances (GSA), and other LGBTQ-related clubs and their students, teacher advisors, and school campus.


